Minutes: November 15, 2011

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:11 a.m.
2. Attendance was recorded by Staff.
3. The minutes of the October 25, 2011 meeting were approved.
4. By consensus the Board approved the copy and size (8" x 24") cast aluminum plates for the seven (7) Bedia plazas; the dedication date was set in February at the Pelican Plaza in the northern portion of The Village Green. The exact date will be coordinated with the Village Clerk; the Board identified the potential sites for the next project: Circle in front of the Community Center, at the entrance to the Beach Park, inside the Beach Park, on the Crandon Blvd. median at the entrance to the Village, Lake Park, and the Fire Station Tower. After discussion, there was consensus to remove two Beach Park sites. There was a consensus that each Boardmember would research clock towers which was suggested in the tower at the Fire Station. Staff suggested that modifications to the Fire Station Tower should be consistent with the overall architectural theme of the Civic Center which is Key West Vernacular. The Board will discuss the sites at the next meeting.
