Minutes: March 12, 2013

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:08 a.m.

3. The minutes of the January 8, 2013 meeting were approved.
4. Jim Drain presented his project which was composed of CBS, embedded glass, and reflective materials. The piece is 7 ft. high and 10 ft. long. He suggested the best location was in the Village Green between the pathway and the tot lot. Christina Lei-Rodriguez presented her project which was composed of triangular impact glass panels arranged in lean to angles. There were 3 options from 1-2 panels and insular panes. She suggested the best location was in the Village Green next to the promenade on the east side near Crandon Boulevard. The panels measured 10 ft. x 12 ft. x 20 ft. Each of the artists was invited to provide greater detail of their artwork including cost at the next meeting. The next meeting was set for May 14.
