

Art in Public Places Board – Work Plan – FY2012

In FY2012 the Art in Public Places Board will begin the process of site selection to identify and contract an artist for the next commission. The educational program will be expanded to include teacher training to conduct tours of the program and to implement classroom-based activities about public art. The program's web site will be promoted as a resource to residents and visitors as well as an integral part of the educational outreach. A temporary art installation will be commissioned for the Village Green. Lighting for framed art works on display will be upgraded to professional standards.
