RE: Art in Public Places Board FY 08 Budget Request for Cultural and Educational Programs

RECOMMENDATION

The Art in Public Places Board has recommended that the Village Council approve the funding for FY08 which consists of:

1. Cultural and Educational Programs: \$23,000
2. Funds for our Art Consultant (separate contract will be provided to the Council in October): \$18,000
3. Supplemental funding for the Bedia project: \$75,000. A separate memorandum has been provided which addresses this subject.

It is recommended that the Council consider this request.

EXPLANATION

The Art in Public Places Work Program consists of three components: Cultural and Educational Programs, funding of the Art Board Consultant, construction and or acquisition of artwork. The Art in Public Places Board has recommended that the Village Council approve the attached FY08 Work Program and funding. Also attached is a list of projects that have been completed by the Art Board since it was created in 2001.
