WHEREAS, the Florida Coastal Cleanup is a statewide effort to clean up the Florida coastline and beaches and increase awareness of marine conservation issues; and

WHEREAS, the Ocean Conservancy serves to educate the public on issues of marine pollution and to use the information collected from the clean up to affect policy changes and other measures needed to reduce marine pollution and enhance marine conversation; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Ocean Conservancy is to promote healthy and diverse ocean ecosystems and to oppose practices that threaten ocean life and human life; and

WHEREAS, through research, education, and science-based advocacy, the Ocean Conservancy informs, inspires, and empowers people to speak and act on behalf of the oceans.
