Whereas, the American Legion Auxiliary Poppy has continued to bloom for the casualties of four wars, its petals of paper bound together for veterans by veterans, reminding America each year that the men and women who have served and died for their country deserve to be remembered; and

Whereas, Poppy Day has become a familiar tradition in almost every American community; and

Whereas, this distribution of the bright red memorial flower to the public is one of the oldest and most widely-recognized programs of the American Legion Auxiliary; and

Whereas, the Village of Key Biscayne extends its support to the American Legion and American Legion Auxiliary.
