RE: Street Name Signs

### **BACKGROUND**

The Village of Key Biscayne currently has an inventory of 484 Street signs (121 intersections) throughout the island. The count consists of 4 aluminum sheets per intersection. Each intersection consists of a pole with street names and a stop sign on the same pole.

At the January 24<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting, the Village Council asked staff to bring back designs for street signs. The Village Manager met with the Key Biscayne Community Foundation regarding preliminary designs that were created for the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration. Village staff began working with Mr. Tom Weber of The Weber Studio who designed the signs for the Foundation. Mr. Weber was asked to prepare street sign designs as well as pole designs. The Weber Studio has prepared the designs pro bono for the Village.

In order to move forward with this project, a design needs to be selected to prepare a bid package for the street signs. The bid package would call for pricing on aluminum signs and wind resistant poles. The Weber Studio has prepared proposals for street signs as well as for the poles (see attached).

The Street Sign project is a Capital Improvement Project. Funding for this project will come from the Transportation Surtax allocation.


Sign Option No. 1 – Lighthouse logo with VKB text.



Sign Option No. 2 – Lighthouse logo without VKB text.




