**RE:** Purchase of Police Traffic Enforcement Motorcycle Equipment and Peripherals.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Village Council approve the Police Department's request to purchase the necessary equipment and peripherals for the new Key Biscayne Police Department Traffic Enforcement Motorcycle Squad.

### **BACKGROUND**

The safety of the Village's residents and visitors is one of the most important aspects of the Village's law enforcement mission, because of its geography and increased pedestrian and bicycle activity within the Rickenbacker Causeway. This increase of vehicular traffic along with pedestrian and bicycle activity has increased the number of serious and fatal accidents within the Causeway. Additionally, the Village of Key Biscayne and Miami-Dade County School Board entered into an Interlocal Agreement to build an educational facility; located within the Causeway; to educate Village students.

The Village Council mandated the creation of a Key Biscayne Police Motorcycle Squad to promote safety education, enforcement of the pedestrian and vehicular laws and ordinances in order to provide proactive traffic enforcement within the Rickenbacker Causeway. To accomplish this mission, the Village of Key Biscayne Police Department Police Motorcycle Squad requires special equipment. The purchase of the equipment and peripherals, if approved, will be funded by the Key Biscayne Police Department Federal Asset Sharing Fund. The Chief of Police attests he has tendered the lowest bid based (attached Exhibit A) upon existing government contracts.

The proceeds of the Village of Key Biscayne Police Department Federal Asset Sharing Fund are the result of seized assets from joint investigations between the Key Biscayne Police Department, Federal and local law enforcement agencies. Said proceeds may be used for programs that are supportive of and consistent with a law enforcement effort, policy or initiative. Police Chief Charles R. Press and the Village Attorney certify that this request clearly falls within the permitted "Law Enforcement Equipment" category contained within A Guide to Equitable Sharing of Federally Forfeited Property for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies.

Currently, the balance of this account is in excess of \$136,000. Police Chief Charles R. Press and I respectfully request to purchase the necessary equipment and peripherals for the Village of Key Biscayne Police Department for an amount not to exceed Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000); see attached proposal as Exhibit A.

**A CAPITAL PROJECT AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KEY BISCAYNE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$24,000.00), FROM THE FEDERAL ASSET SHARING FUND TO COVER THE COSTS OF EQUIPING THE NEWLY FORMED POLICE MOTORCYCLE SQUAD; PROVIDING FOR A WAIVER OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, pedestrian and bicycle activity has increased to the point it has taxed the Rickenbacker Causeway (the "Causeway") to its limit; and

**WHEREAS**, this increased activity has raised the number of accidents within the Causeway; and

**WHEREAS**, some of these accidents have occurred between motor vehicles and bicyclists, resulting in grave injuries and/or death; and

**WHEREAS**, such accidents has impacted the lives of the residents and visitors of the Village of Key Biscayne (the "Village"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village and the Miami-Dade County School Board have entered into an Interlocal Agreement to build an educational facility to educate up to one-thousand (1,000) Village school children at a location along the Causeway; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council in its concern for the safety and welfare of the residents and visitors to the Village who travel the Causeway has authorized the formation of a Traffic Enforcement Police Motorcycle Squad (the "Motorcycle Squad") to address this issue; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Police Department (the "Police Department") members that are assigned to the Motorcycle Squad require special equipment to perform their assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, this expenditure was not included in the Police Department's operating budget costs/police equipment line item; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has in excess of \$136,000.00 in the Federal Asset Sharing Fund Account; and

WHEREAS, these monies are the result of seized assets from joint investigations between the Police Department and Federal Agencies, not from tax revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined that costs for "Other Law Enforcement Purposes" is an authorized expenditure category contained within "A Guide to Equitable Sharing of Federally Forfeiture Property for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies;" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-85 of the Village Code, the Village Council finds it impracticable to competitively bid this equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that the adoption of this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF KEY BISCAVNE, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals Adopted:** That each of the recitals stated above are hereby adopted and confirmed.

**Section 2. Purchase Authorized.** That the Chief of Police is hereby authorized to purchase the equipment necessary for the Motorcycle Squad as described in Attachment "A" for a total expenditure not to exceed \$24,000.00. The funds for this purchase will come from the Federal Asset Sharing Fund Account.

**Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding.** That the Village Council hereby finds that following the competitive bid procedures for the purchase of the Motorcycle Squad

equipment is impracticable and it is appropriate to waive such procedures in accordance with Section 2-85 of the Village Code.

**Section 4.** **Effective Date:** That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.






