# FLORIDA RED-LIGHT SAFETY CAMERA FACTS



Red-light runners caused

**4,803** traffic injuries  
in Florida in 2012

costing communities more than

**\$646** million.

# FLORIDA RED-LIGHT SAFETY CAMERA FACTS



Red-light running fatalities

decreased

**27%** in Florida from **83 in 2011**  
to **61 in 2012.**



The 22 lives saved amount to an economic  
savings to communities of more than

**\$132 million.**

**Driver behavior is changing.**

**More than 95%**

of drivers who received and paid a notice of violation in 2013 did not receive a second.



# FLORIDA RED-LIGHT SAFETY CAMERA FACTS

Of the agencies responding to a 2013 Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles survey, nearly



**59%** reported a decrease in total crashes.



Similarly, of the 44 agencies tracking crashes,



**61%** reported a decrease in side-impact collisions



while



**43%** reported a decrease in rear-end crashes.
