

RESOLUTION NO. 2018- _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KEY BISCAYNE, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD REFERENDUM TO APPROVE AN AD VALOREM LEVY OF 0.75 MILLS TO IMPROVE COMPENSATION FOR TEACHERS AND INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL AND INCREASE SCHOOL SAFETY AND SECURITY PERSONNEL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County School Board (the “School Board”) has placed a referendum on the November 6, 2018 General Election Ballot (the “Ballot”) to approve an ad valorem levy of 0.75 mills to improve compensation for high quality teachers and instructional personnel and increase school safety and security personnel, with oversight by a Citizen Advisory Committee, beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2023 (the “Referendum”); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Key Biscayne (the “Village”) Council wishes to express its support of the School Board’s Referendum; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KEY BISCAYNE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That each of the above-stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Supporting Referendum. That the Village Council hereby supports the School Board Referendum.

Section 3. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
